The fourth F-105 RTU Class 67BR graduated at McConnell AFB KS. The class started on 16 May 66 with 15 pilots. It was named "The Lickity Splits" and consisted of 2 Lt Cols, 8 Majs, and 5 Capts.

On 27 Jun 66, Lt Col Charles F. Neff, Jr. was the second 23 TFW RTU student fatality when he crashed in F-105D 59-1767 during a training mission.

The class deployed 14 F-105s with the 560 TFS to George AFB CA between 23 Aug - 19 Sep 66 for conventional weapons delivery training. The squadron commander was Maj Everett W. Harris. Maj Alfred J. Lagrou, Jr. was the Top Gun and Outstanding Pilot.

Waller/Maj James Phillip Padgett), Fitz (Lt Col Gerald F. "Jerry" Fitzgerald), Smith (Capt Frank M. Smith), Blake. "Iron Hand to Hanoi. Two circuits up and down Thud Ridge. One SAM across canopy about 1,000 feet away. Outstanding mission. Larry Waller was Weasel and Padgett EWO. The best."

Maj. Marlin R. Blake from the 13 TFS, 388 TFW, Korat, RTAFB, Thailand, flew his 62nd combat mission. He led four F-105Ds in "Stinger" flight.

Stinger 3 - Capt Edgar W. "Ed" Michie flying 62-4359

Stinger was the fourth of five F-105 flights from Korat: Crab (Iron Hand), Hotrod, Tampa, Stinger, Fosdick. Plymouth and Bobcat were two other Iron Hand flights. Mayor and Texas were two F-4 CAP flights. Wasp and Nitro were EB-66 ECM flights.

"Refueled and went towards Hanoi. About 50 miles south started getting SAM signals. About 42 miles out we had three SAMs fired at us. Broke down and they missed. Continued outbound and dropped our 3,000-pounders on Route 6. Bad weather all over. Everything all fouled up from start to almost end. Refueling off course. Formation spread. Weather bad. SAMs."

The 388 TFW history covering the period 1 April - 31 July 1967 listed 79 names of F-105 Wild Weasel, Ryan's Raiders, and strike crews in the 13 TFS.

One of the Wild Weasel crews in the 13 TFS was Capt Robert E. Dorrough and his EWO Maj Clarence S. Summers who arrived on 29 June 1967.

One of the strike pilots was Lt Col Gerald F. "Jerry" Fitzgerald, former 13 TFS squadron commander, who flew his 100th mission on 1 June 1967.

Capt Frank M. Smith was a 13 TFS strike pilot departing on 1 Jun 67. He was awarded the Silver Star for the period Apr - Jul 67.
